- cyberbullying by using the internet or mobile phones.

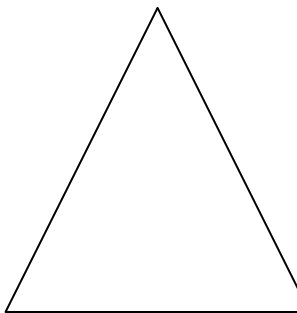
You can help by:
